STUDENT ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES

MINISTERIAL TRAINING (TO ATTAIN LEVEL OF A LICENSED MINISTER OR ORDINATION @ TPH)

REGISTRATION Tuition Fee \$250 per semester
Spring (January–May) & Fall (August–December)
2 Year Training Program – Total of 4 Semesters

New Students (Entry Level) required to submit:

1. A completed application form
2. A completed Background Check Release Form
3. A PHSOM DIGITAL PHOTO

TYPICAL SEMESTER: 18 **Tuesday** Evening Class Room Sessions; 36 lecture hours per semester.
Classes to begin promptly at 7 p.m. and ending at 9 p.m. Suggested time of arrival is 6:45 p.m. This will allow the student time to prepare for the class; late arrivals, after 7:15 p.m. be recorded as an unexcused absence.

DRESS CODE: PHSOM students are expected to attend each class session in Business Casual Attire. A good guideline is to dress according to the excellence of your call. Hold a standard in your mind as to what you would wear to lead a congregation in corporate prayer.

- ❑ All PHSOM Studies are accompanied by a PHSOM Student Study Guide (SSG) – Accessible only to registered students.
- ❑ Each SSG can be accessed (by registered students only) at www.discussphsom.com 10 days prior to classroom lecture.
- ❑ The Discussion Board is open to an on-line Q&A for all students, with instructors present, every Thursday evening, 7-8pm.
- ❑ PHSOM students are expected to print out their SSG and **study thoroughly prior** to bringing their copy to the Tuesday class session along with their study **Bible (KJV)**.
- ❑ PHSOM students are expected to attend each Class Lecture **fully prepared to participate** in class discussion and, if required, to respond to an impromptu oral or written quiz.
- ❑ Both the Class Lecture and the Student Study Guide are used to formulate the semester's Final Exam.

ABSENCE OR LATE ARRIVAL: All absences and late arrivals must be excused. PHSOM Students are to obtain an excused status on all of their absences and/or late arrivals by reporting all such (with explanation as to cause) to attendphsom@gmail.com within 24 hours of the occurrence. **More than 3 absences will require the semester be retaken in its entirety.**
ALL EARLY DEPARTURES FROM CLASS SESSIONS WILL BE COUNTED AS AN ABSENCE
